Please note that the lector schedule includes two readers at each of the weekend Liturgies.

The 1st Reader will carry in procession the Book of Gospels, place it on the altar, and proclaim the 1st reading. After the reading he/she will return to the pews. It is important for this reader to arrive early enough to set correctly the ribbons both in the Lectionary and Gospel Book. If in doubt, check the Missal for the Sunday's Readings.

If a Deacon is present, he will carry in the Book of Gospels and lead the Prayers of the Faithful.

The 2nd Reader will proclaim the 2nd Reading, remove the Lectionary, and read the Intercessions. After the Intercessions, he/she will return to the pews. Ordinarily, Father Kent makes the Announcements at the end of the Mass. In the case of a Visiting Priest, then the responsibility falls to the 2nd Reader.

The Gospel Book is left on the Lectern, and the Lectors do not walk out in procession with Father.

If you are not able to be there for your assigned date, please get a substitute. The names and telephone numbers of the Sacred Heart Lectors are listed on the lector directory.

The Lector is called to serve the needs of the assembly, the people gathered to hear the word. He / She proclaims the word that strengthens the faith of God's people. Thank you for your willingness to serve our parish in this important ministry.
